DAY 1 Vancouver to Kamloops

At Rocky Mountaineer Vancouver Station, board the world-renowned Rocky Mountaineer train. Pass through the fertile fields of the Fraser Valley and view the towering peaks of the Coast Mountains before entering the Fraser Canyon. See the thundering waters of Hell's Gate and follow the Thompson River to historic Kamloops, gateway to the Interior of British Columbia. Stay overnight in moderate accommodations in Kamloops.

DAY 2 Kamloops to Banff or Calgary

Continue east through the vast ranchlands along the South Thompson River, pass Craigellachie, where the "Last Spike" of the Canadian Pacific Railway was driven, and enter Rogers Pass, with its tunnels, snowsheds and glistening glaciers. Climb through the Spiral Tunnels and over the Continental Divide to Banff National Park. End your rail journey in Banff or continue on to the "Stampede City" of Calgary.

Rocky Mountaineer Yellowhead Route

DAY 1 Vancouver to Kamloops

At Rocky Mountaineer Vancouver Station, board the world-renowned Rocky Mountaineer train. Pass through the fertile fields of the Fraser Valley and view the towering peaks of the Coast Mountains before entering the Fraser Canyon. See the thundering waters of Hell's Gate and follow the Thompson River to historic Kamloops, gateway to the Interior of British Columbia. Stay overnight in moderate accommodations in Kamloops.

DAY 2 Kamloops to Jasper

Rejoin the Rocky Mountaineer and follow the Thompson River through rolling plateaus into the snowy peaks of the Monashee Mountains. View Pyramid Falls and the expansive glaciers of the Alberta Icefields before passing by Mount Robson, which at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet) is the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. In late afternoon, arrive in Jasper, located in the largest mountain park in Canada.

DAY 1 Whistler to Quesnel

Board the world-famous Rocky Mountaineer train for a two-day journey on this exciting route. Enjoy breathtaking and varied scenery, including the winding lakeshores of Anderson and Seton Lakes, the desert-like conditions of the Fraser Canyon and the vast ranchlands of the Cariboo Plateau. 





1. General Terms and Conditions

2. Brochure Prices

All prices herein are quoted in Canadian or U.S. dollars. Prices and information in this brochure are for the 2008 season and are subject to change without notice.

3. Canadian Goods and Services Tax (GST) All prices are subject to GST, which will be charged upon confirmation of booking. Currently the rate is 6% for Canadian GST. Guests who are not residents of Canada are eligible for a rebate of the GST paid on short-term accommodation. If they are purchasing their rail tour from outside Canada Rocky Mountaineer Vacations may claim the rebate on their behalf. The result is a 50% reduction in the tax rate, and 3% is then used to calculate the GST to be charged. When non-resident quests purchase their rail tour while in Canada, Rocky Mountaineer Vacations charges GST at the full 6% rate, and any GST rebate to which a visitor to Canada may be entitled must be claimed from the Canada Customs and Revenue Agency by the guest. This short-term accommodation rebate is subject to change without notice.

4. Rail-Only and Package Tour Inclusions

The following costs are not included unless otherwise specified: GST, gratuities, alcoholic beverages, meals, room service or other hotel incidentals, items of a personal nature and all other items not specified in the description of the annicable tour contained in this benchmark for a far and the second s applicable tour contained in this brochure.
